### YOUR STAY

On the day of your departure (Saturday) please check out before 10am.

Below is a reminder of the steps to follow before proceeding with the check out .

#### During your stay:

- It is forbidden to smoke in the chalet (otherwise we will not refund the entire deposit).
- Please remove your ski boots or boots when you use the wooden stairs.
- Be eco-responsible a recycling terminal is at your disposal next to the chalet along the river, for all types of waste.
- Please turn off the lights, turn down the heating & close the windows before you go skiing.
- Switch off the heaters when windows are opened

#### Before you leave :

- Clean the kitchen area and the table, empty the fridge and cupboards.
- Turn on the dishwasher.
- Empty the garbage cans and put the garbage bags and glass bottles in the sorting collection points.
- Put the used sheets (not the mattress protection) in the fabric bags and the towels in the nets. Put the bags of dirty laundry and bath mats outside on the bank.
- Put the furniture back in the right place

After these steps, the cleaning at the end of your stay is included in the service.



Enjoy the fire place during your stay. 1 bag of wood pellets is included. Additional bags will be charged 10€ / bag at the end of your stay. The stove is set up to provide a pleasant warmth, please do not modify the set up and contact Cedric if needed +33 6 86 87 37 97.

#### How it works :



It is normal that the stove is filled with thick smoke on startup. The smoke disappears after 5-10 min.



- OFF: long press (5 sec) on
- **Refilling pellets:** press the top of the stove.

A trapdoor opens. Pour the pellets slowly. Close the trapdoor.

• Refilling can be done while the stove is on.

#### For your safety :

- The stove can **ONLY** be filled with wood pellets (please do not burn anything else)
- It is strictly forbidden to remove the ash with a vacuum cleaner: **Risk of fire!**

The hot tub water is renewed and treated weekly .

Do not empty or refill the water on your own.

# The use of the hot tub and sauna is at your own risk. We disclaim all liability for personal injury or damage to property in connection with their use. Parents are liable for their children .

In order for you to fully enjoy the spa during your stay, we ask you to follow a few simple advices.

#### How to use the hot tub and safety rules

- Remove the SPA cover by using the handle <u>and close</u> <u>again after each use.</u>
- Children MUST be accompanied by a responsible adult. Parents are liable for their children .
- Due to high temperatures, the hot tub is not recommended for pregnant women, young children, people with high blood pressure or people with heart disease.
- •The recommended duration of use is 15 minutes.
- Do not enter the spa while intoxicated or under the influence of drugs that could cause drowsiness.
- Do not use any electrical equipment near water, such as a hair dryer.
- Always be careful when entering or exiting the hot tub (risk of slipping).

#### **Hygiene rules**

- Take a shower before entering the hot tub to remove any remaining body lotion, sock pilling or other residue that clogs the filter.
- Do not use any products into the hot tub (shower gel, essential oils, bubble bath, etc.).
- STRICTLY FORBIDDEN : cigarettes, chewing gum, food and beverages (e.g. beer bottles).



• Do not wear jewellery in a sauna. Metal can get hot and burn the skin.

**SAUNA** 

- Always sit on your towel.
- Do not eat or drink alcoholic beverages in the sauna .
- Avoid the sauna if you have high blood pressure or heart disease, and get out at the slightest sign of discomfort or significant acceleration of your heartbeat.
